## The Greeting

Grace mercy and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ be with you **and also with you.**

## Opening prayer

**Almighty God,  
to whom all hearts are open, all desires known,  
and from whom no secrets are hidden:  
cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of your  
Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love you,  
and worthily magnify your holy name;  
through Christ our Lord. Amen**

## Prayers of Penitence

*We are invited to confess our sins. Silence is kept.*

**Almighty God, our heavenly Father, we have sinned against you  
and against our neighbour, in thought and word and deed,  
through negligence, through weakness, through our own  
deliberate fault. We are truly sorry and repent of all our sins.  
For the sake of your Son Jesus Christ, who died for us, forgive us  
all that is past and grant that we may serve you in newness of  
life to the glory of your name. Amen.**

***The President pronounces God's absolution***

Almighty God, who forgives all who truly repent, have mercy upon you, pardon and deliver you from all your sins, confirm and strengthen you in all goodness, and keep you in life eternal; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

**The Gloria**

***We say the Gloria together or listen to a sung Gloria recorded from home by our choir.***

**Glory to God in the highest,  
and peace to his people on earth.**

**Lord God, heavenly King, almighty God and Father,  
we worship you, we give you thanks,  
we praise you for your glory.**

**Lord Jesus Christ, only Son of the Father,  
Lord God, Lamb of God,  
you take away the sin of the world: have mercy on us;  
you are seated at the right hand of the Father:  
receive our prayer.**

**For you alone are the Holy One,  
you alone are the Lord,  
you alone are the Most High.  
Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit,  
in the glory of God the Father. Amen.**

**The Collect**

# The Liturgy of the Word

## Readings

*The first reading of the day is read by a member of our church community.*

Hear the word of the Lord. **Thanks be to God.**

## Gospel Reading

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to *M*

*We say: Glory to you, O Lord*

*At the end*

This is the Gospel of the Lord.

*We say: Praise to you, O Christ.*

## The Sermon

*The sermon is given by one of our own clergy (Revd Canon Rachel or Revd Carol) or a guest preacher.*

## The Creed

*You may wish to stand as we declare our faith.*

**We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty,  
maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.**

**We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ,  
the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father,  
God from God, Light from Light,  
true God from true God, begotten, not made,  
of one Being with the Father; through him all things were made.**

**For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven,  
was incarnate from the Holy Spirit and the Virgin Mary  
and was made man.**

**For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate;  
he suffered death and was buried.**

**On the third day he rose again in accordance with the  
Scriptures; he ascended into heaven  
and is seated at the right hand of the Father.  
He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead,  
and his kingdom will have no end.**

**We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life,  
who proceeds from the Father and the Son,  
who with the Father and the Son is worshipped and glorified,  
who has spoken through the prophets.**

**We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church.  
We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins.  
We look for the resurrection of the dead,  
and the life of the world to come. Amen.**

Merciful Father, **accept these prayers  
for the sake of your Son, our Saviour Jesus Christ. Amen.**

# The Liturgy of the Sacrament

With this bread that we bring **we shall remember Jesus**  
With this wine that we bring **we shall remember Jesus**  
Bread for his body, wine for his blood, gifts from God to his table  
we bring. **We shall remember Jesus.**

## The Eucharistic Prayer

*The President sings*

The Lord is here. **His spirit is with us**  
Lift up your hearts. **We lift them to the Lord**  
Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.  
**It is right to give thanks and praise.**

*The President praises God for his mighty acts and all respond singing or saying:*

**Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might,  
heaven and earth are full of your glory.  
Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is he who comes in the name of  
the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.**

*The President recalls the Last Supper.*

Great is the mystery of faith:

***We say:*** Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will come again

*The prayer continues and at the end we all respond boldly*

**Amen.**

*SILENCE is kept – and we kneel to pray if able.*

## **The Lord's Prayer**

Trusting in the compassion of God,  
let us pray with confidence as Jesus taught us:  
**Our Father who art in heaven,  
hallowed be thy name,  
thy kingdom come, thy will be done,  
on earth as it is in heaven.  
Give us this day our daily bread.  
And forgive us our trespasses  
as we forgive those who trespass against us.  
Lead us not into temptation  
but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom,  
the power, and the glory forever and ever. Amen.**

We break this bread to share in the body of Christ.  
**Though we are many, we are one body,  
because we all share in one bread.**

## Agnus Dei

Jesus Lamb of God have mercy on us.  
Jesus bearer of our sins, have mercy on us.  
Jesus redeemer of the world, grant us peace.

As I receive these gifts on behalf of our community may we all know the power of God's love in this moment and in our lives each day.

The body of Christ. **Amen.**  
The blood of Christ. **Amen.**
